

JCHEA Math Blog Instructions

We are introducing a new Math Blog that will have a lot more functionality for its users to share and discuss ideas. The new “blog” will be hosted through Google Groups. Through this site, users will be able to post and reply to discussions, upload files and download uploaded files, and create pages with images, and links. To access this group you will need a Google account. If you already have a Google account you want to use, skip to Step 2.

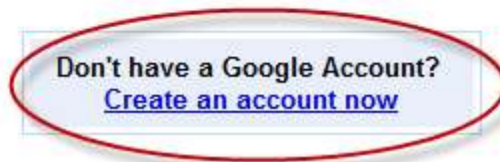
Step 1: Sign up for a Google Account

Please note that signing up for a Google account does not mean that you are signing up for an email account.

1. Go to <http://www.google.com/> and click “Sign in” in the upper right side of the page.



2. Click on “Create an account now”

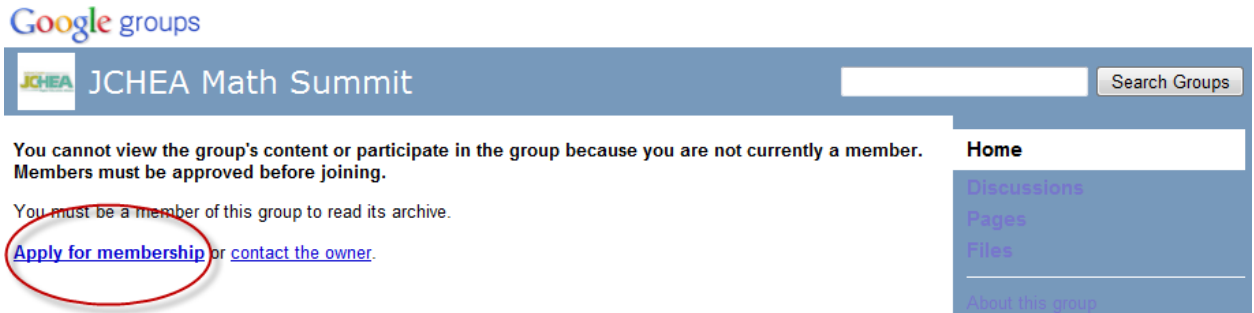

3. Fill out the form. You can use either your work or home email address. Once finished, click “I accept. Create my account” at the bottom of the page.

4. In a few minutes you should receive an email notification in the email account you provided asking you to verify and activate your account.

Step 2: Apply for membership to the group.

1. Go to <http://groups.google.com/group/jchea-math-summit>. You can also access the blog through the JCHEA website under Education Summits.
2. Click “Apply for membership.” If you are not already signed in to your Google Account, the link will appear as “Sign in and apply for membership” in the same location.



3. Edit your membership Preferences.
 - a. Choose How you want to be notified of group activity
 - b. Choose your nickname. (how you want other members to view your name)
 - c. Click the link “Apply to this group.”

4. Your request will be sent to the moderator(s) for approval.
5. Once approved you will receive an email confirming your status.
